**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE INITIAL BRIEF**

The petitioner asks for an extension of time to file the initial petition for a *writ of certiorari* and motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The petitioner relocated and was married during preparation of this Petition. Rulings ignoring human dignity were just made in the Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals and the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals substantively impacting this claim as well as presentations made before the Supreme Court on gay marriage and the Affordable Care Act ignoring impacts to human dignity.

The impact on U. S. culture is assured with respect to forced actions, forced speech, and forced dishonor. This instant case should allow United States Courts to begin addressing the fundamental, natural human right to protect dignity missing since May 31, 1790 though protected in England since 1734. This universal human right, respected in (160) honorable Berne Convention Signatory nations, leaves United States' dishonorable exception.

The unrecognized human right to protect dignity explains U.S. disputes over gay marriage, gestation regulation, and copy[rite] violations or loss of personal privacy “online” as well as any dispute involving individual personal honor including *Citizens United*. All *American* citizen honor today depends on relative wealth, as voids realistic democracy. Moral superiority regarding human dignity explains recognition of a “*right to be forgotten*” in the EU and why *American* Free Speech is clearly over-broad.

This petitioner prays for sixty (60) days time extension for the initial brief submission, as a procedural matter per Fed Rules of Appellate Procedure Rule 27, from September 16, 2015 to November 15, 2015.
